- Saturday Feb. 4 6:00 pm Service of Praise, Prayer and Holy Communion led by Pastor Fred Roberts in our chapel, with meditation on Psalm 119:9-14 and Mark 6:30-34.
- Sunday Feb 5 *"Our Choice of Companions"* is the topic of Pastor Fred Roberts' sermon drawn from 1 Corinthians 9:16-23 and Mark 1:29-39 at the 8:15 am, 9:30 am (Contemporary) and 11:00 a.m. worship services.
